

Visit to the Museum 15:00 – 16:30 and to the site 17:00 – 18:00 Departure at 18:15 and back to Dijon city centre around 19:45 The MuséoParc Alésia commemorates the historical events at Alésia and includes three main sites: a museum showcasing the history from prehistory to now, the ruins of the Gallo-Roman city, and a statue of Vercingetorix created by Napoleon III.



Rehabilitation of the Schneider warehouses. Visit to the Centre universitaire Condorcet, uB. Affiliated with the University of Burgundy, the Condorcet University Center in Le Creusot is located on the South Burgundy Campus and housed in a renovated industrial A stop at the 1826 workers' housing estate: Cité de la Combe des Mineurs, listed as a historic monument and restored as social housing Chateau de la Verrerie: Located in the main body of the Château de la Verrerie, the Musée de l'Homme et de l'Industrie (Museum of Man and Industry) is one of the sites of the Ecomusée Creusot Montceau. The Ecomusée aims to study and highlight the heritage and people of the region, which is marked by its mining, steel, ceramic, and glass industries, as well as its landscapes and living areas. The permanent collections of the Musée de l'Homme et de l'Industrie trace the history of this 'factory-castle,' created at the end of the 18th century to house the Royal Manufacture of Crystals and Enamels for the Queen Marie-Visit to Beaune and/or to the Hotel-Dieu for those interested Hotel-Dieu: Owned by the Hospices Civils de Beaune, the Hôtel-Dieu is a remarkably well-preserved heritage site, founded in 1443 by Nicolas Rolin, Chancellor of the Duke of Burgundy, and his last wife Guigone de Salins.
